## *BIPOLAR DISORDER*

Tuesday, November 8, 2011

Bipolar Disorder, called Maniacal-Depressive Insanity when described more than one hundred years ago, has served as a major fulcrum for diagnostic decision making and a vortex from which many diagnostic eddies have spawned. It is often considered in the differential diagnosis when disturbances of behavior, mood, or thought are present. Despite more than a century of progressive awareness, decades of serious scientific research, and an expanding armamentarium of pharmaceutical treatments, bipolar disorder remains largely unexplained, frequently misdiagnosed, and often inadequately controlled. This presentation will review common aspects of bipolar disorder, presentations that are not bipolar disorder, current pharmacotherapy, and other considerations for diagnosis and treatment.

**Kevin Miller, M.D.**, completed a fellowship in mood disorders at Yale University School of Medicine and is Clinical Associate Professor of Psychiatry at St. Louis University School of Medicine. Dr. Miller has served on the speakers bureaus for several pharmaceutical companies that make medications used to treat mood disorders. He currently practices adult psychiatry in Missouri and Illinois with expertise in mood and anxiety disorders, addictions and eating disorders. He has been trained in hypnosis, EMDR, and Internal Family Systems therapy, and has a special interest and expertise in the medication and psychotherapeutic treatment of psychological trauma and dissociation.
